



Instructions on how to upgrade your wallet to the latest version

Windows:

1. Backup your wallet.dat file:
 - a. Go to C:\Users\ - b. Delete all files and folders other than credits.conf
masternode.conf and wallet.dat
2. Download the latest wallet from <https://github.com/CRDS/Credits/releases/download/v1.4.0.0/credits-1.4.0-win64-qt.exe>
3. Run the .exe
4. Start the wallet and wait for it to connect to the nodes (can take a while).

Linux:

1. Backup your wallet.dat file
 - a. `cp ~/.credits/wallet.dat /some_dir/wallet.dat`
 - b. Otherwise, make sure that you have a balance of 0 by running `./credits-cli getinfo`
2. Shutdown the daemon
 - a. `./credits-cli stop`
3. Run these commands to clean up the old code:

```
cd ~/.credits
rm -f *.log net*.dat peers.dat fee*.dat netf*.dat mnp*.dat gov*.dat mnc*.dat
bootstrap.tar.gz
rm -rf blocks chainstate backups database
wget
https://github.com/CRDS/Credits/releases/download/v1.4.0.0/bootstrap.tar.gz
tar -xzf bootstrap.tar.gz
cd ~
```
4. Download & install the new wallet version

```
cd ~
wget https://github.com/CRDS/Credits/releases/download/v1.4.0.0/credits-1.4.0-linux.tar.gz
tar -xzf credits-1.4.0-linux.tar.gz
cd credits-1.4.0-linux
./creditsd --daemon
```
