

Instructions on how to upgrade your wallet to the next version

- The upgrade to the new wallet is **mandatory**.
- The new version includes the following changes:
 - The required Masternode collateral changed from 500 CRDS to 5,000 CRDS.
 - The code was updated to ensure that blocks too far ahead or behind the current network version won't be accepted anymore.
 - AVX2 support was added back into the AVX2 version of the Windows wallet.

Windows:

1. Backup your wallet.dat file:
 - a. Go to C:\Users\\AppData\Roaming\Credits
 - b. Copy the "wallet.dat" file and paste it somewhere else.
2. Download the new wallet from
<https://github.com/CRDS/Credits/releases/tag/1.1.0.0>
3. Run the .exe and follow the steps through the installation wizard (This will overwrite your old version).
4. Start the wallet and wait for it to connect to the nodes (can take a while).

Linux:

1. Backup your wallet.dat file
 - a. `cp ~/.credits/wallet.dat /some_dir/wallet.dat`
 - b. Otherwise, make sure that you have a balance of 0 by running
`./credits-cli getinfo`
2. Shutdown the daemon
 - a. `./credits-cli stop`
3. Run these commands to clean up the old code:
 - a. `cd ~`
 - b. `rm -f ~/.credits/*.conf`
 - c. `rm -rf credits*`
 - d. `rm -rf Credits*`
4. Download & install the new wallet version
 - a. `cd ~`
 - b. `wget`

 - c. `tar -xzf credits-1.1.0.tar.gz`
 - d. `cd credits-1.1.0`
 - e. `./creditsd --daemon`
