



## Instructions on how to upgrade your wallet to the next version

- The upgrade to the new wallet is **mandatory**.
- The new version includes the following changes:
  - Prevents wallet crashes due to incorrect block time stamps.

### Windows:

1. Backup your wallet.dat file:
  - a. Go to C:\Users\\AppData\Roaming\Credits
  - b. Copy the "wallet.dat" file and paste it somewhere else.
2. Download the new wallet from <https://github.com/CRDS/Credits/releases/tag/v1.1.1.0>
3. Run the .exe and follow the steps through the installation wizard (This will overwrite your old version).
4. Start the wallet and wait for it to connect to the nodes (can take a while).

### Linux:

1. Backup your wallet.dat file
  - a. `cp ~/.credits/wallet.dat /some_dir/wallet.dat`
  - b. Otherwise, make sure that you have a balance of 0 by running `./credits-cli getinfo`
2. Shutdown the daemon
  - a. `./credits-cli stop`
3. Run these commands to clean up the old code:
  - a. `cd ~`
  - b. `rm -f ~/.credits/*.conf`
  - c. `rm -rf credits*`
  - d. `rm -rf Credits*`
4. Download & install the new wallet version
  - a. `cd ~`
  - b. `wget`

  - c. `tar -xzf credits-1.1.1-64bit.tar.gz`
  - d. `cd creditsd-1.1.1-linux`
  - e. `./creditsd --daemon`
